**O R D E R**

The Government of India has fixed the support price of two basic varieties of cotton viz, medium staple length relating to F-414/H-777/J-34 and long staple length relating to H-4/H-6 of new crop seed cotton (kapas) of Fair Average Quality of cotton season 2007-08. The support price for medium staple length has been fixed at Rs.1800/- per quintal. Similarly, the support price for long staple length has been fixed at Rs.2030/- per quintal.

2. Based on the support prices for these two basic varieties and taking into account the quality differential, normal price differential and other relevant factors, the support prices for other varieties of kapas of Fair Average Quality for the cotton season 2007-08 (October-September) are hereby fixed, as under: -
